

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-0317

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING A LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY FOR
WARREN COUNTY, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, Warren County, Indiana has been impacted by or is immediately threatened by the Coronavirus (COVID-19).

WHEREAS, at 7:00 a.m. on March 16, 2020, in recognition of the global COVID-19 pandemic and the significant risk to the health and safety of the citizens of Warren County, the Fountain & Warren County Health Department hereby declared a public health emergency for no less than 30 days and;

NOW THEREFORE, the Warren County Board of Commissioners hereby declare that a local public health emergency exists in the County, invoke and declare those portions of the Indiana Code which are applicable to these emergency conditions, and have caused the issuance of this proclamation, to be in full force and effect in the County for the exercise of all necessary emergency authority for protection of the lives and property of the people of this County and the restoration of local government with a minimum of interruption.

This Declaration was approved by the Board of County Commissioners at an emergency meeting of the Board of Commissioners held on Tuesday, March 17, 2020, conducted in accordance with Indiana's Open Door Law or at an emergency meeting of the Board of County Commissioners which complied with the Open Door Law requirements for such an emergency meeting in accordance with IC 5-14-1.5-5 (d).


Reference is hereby made to all appropriate laws, statutes, ordinances, and resolutions and particularly to Indiana Code 10-14-3-29.

All public offices and employees of Warren County are hereby directed to exercise the utmost diligence in the discharge of duties required of them for the duration of the emergency and in execution of emergency laws, regulations, and directives— state and local.


All citizens are called upon and directed to comply with necessary emergency measures, to cooperate with public officials and response services in executing emergency operations plans, and to obey and comply with the lawful directions of properly identified officers.


All operating forces will direct their communications and requests for assistance and operations directly to the Warren County Emergency Operating Center.


