

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-0707C

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ACCESSIBILITY COALITION IN
WARREN COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Warren County, Indiana believe it is in the best interests of its citizens to form an Accessibility Coalition to advise and assist with the implementation of Title VI and Americans with Disabilities Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Warren County, Indiana, that the Warren County Code shall be amended to include the following Section.

§ _____ ACCESSIBILITY COALITION

(A) There is hereby created an Accessibility Coalition, which shall consist of the following persons appointed by the Commissioners:

1. One member of the Board of Commissioners, which shall include
President
2. One member of the County Council, which shall include:
President
3. The Director of the Warren County Highway Department, Jenny Hobaugh;
4. The Warren County Human Resources Director, Jill Wilson; and
5. The Warren County Maintenance Director, Russ Haddock.

(B) Each member shall be appointed for a term of one year commencing on January 1 of each year and shall serve until his or her successor is appointed and qualified.

(C) The Accessibility Coalition shall be an advisory body that will meet as required and make written recommendations to the Commissioners regarding the design, construction, alteration or operation of Warren County facilities and their accessibility and usability by individuals with disabilities, in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and Title VI, and other such duties as may be assigned by the Board of Commissioners.

(D) The Board of Commissioners shall annually appoint one member of the Accessibility Coalition to serve as the ADA Coordinator for the County.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signing.




