

RESOLUTION 2006-11

Whereas, The past three years have been very challenging for the Warren County Council, our goal has been to draft a balanced budget without cutting services to the County's citizens. We want to reward the County's employees as best we can all while working with a reduced maximum levy. So far we have achieved our goal. We have cut capital expenditures and some other non-essentials. We have not levied taxes on the healthiest funds such as Reassessment which has allowed that levy to help shore up the County General Fund. These measures can only be temporary. In an effort to help improve efficiency, the County Council and County Commissioners have decided to implement the following policy.

Therefore, be it resolved, that whenever a position is vacated, for whatever reason, the County Council, County Commissioners and the affected Department Head will conduct a review. This review will explore the possibility of redefining duties and/or using part time help to eliminate the need to fill the vacated position.
