

RESOLUTION -2005 - 02

WARREN COUNTY COUNCIL:

INCREASING SOLID WASTE DISTRICT PROPERTY TAX LEVY BY MORE THAN FIVE PERCENT (5%) IN ONE YEAR.

WHEREAS, IND Code 13-21-3-16(b) reads, To be eligible to include in the district's budget for the following year tax revenue derived from the imposition of a property tax, the first year that a property tax will be imposed and any subsequent year in which the proposed property tax levy will increase by five percent (5%) or more, a board must present identical resolutions to each of the county fiscal bodies within the district seeking approval for the use of the property tax revenue with in the district; and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Solid Waste District proposes to raise the property tax levy to a maximum of seven percent (7%) in order to cover escalating Insurance Expenses; and

WHEREAS, (1) a "yes" vote indicates approval of the levy and the proposed use of property tax revenue within the district; and (2) a "no" vote indicates disapproval of the levy and the proposed use of property tax revenue with in the district;

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WARREN COUNTY COUNCIL that it does authorize the property tax levy for the Warren County Solid Waste District to increase to a maximum of seven percent (7%) to be used for Insurance Expenses.


