

ORDINANCE 91-4

1. If the proper officers of a county department, which term shall be defined as any office or unit of county government having a budget which requires the approval of the county council, desires to reallocate or transfer funds within a major budget classification, they shall follow the procedures set forth in this ordinance.
2. The proper officers of such unit may transfer money within a major budget classification if:
 - a. They determine that the transfer is necessary;
 - b. The transfer does not require the expenditure of more money than the total amount set out in such major budget classification;
 - c. The transfer is certified to the County Auditor;
 - d. The transfer is approved by the County Council.
3. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage.
