

ORDINANCE NO. 9806
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
WARREN COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, IC 5-22 (the "Act") applies to every expenditure of public funds by a governmental body;

WHEREAS, Warren County (the "County") is a governmental body under the Act;
and

WHEREAS, the Act requires the County to establish certain purchasing rules and policies for the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WARREN COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. The following are the required purchasing rules for County, Indiana:

Purchase of Supplies Manufactured in the United States. Supplies manufactured in the United States shall be specified for all County purchases and shall be purchased unless the County determines that:

- (A) the supplies are not manufactured in the United States in reasonably available quantities;
- (B) the prices of the supplies manufactured in the United States exceeds by an unreasonable amount the price of available and comparable supplies manufactured elsewhere;
- (C) the quality of the supplies manufactured in the United States is substantially less than the quality of comparably priced available supplies manufactured elsewhere: or
- (D) the purchase of supplies manufactured in the United States is not in the public interest.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is effective upon passage and signing by the presiding officer.

Adopted by the Board of Commissioners of Warren County, Indiana, this 29 day of June, 1998, by a vote of 3 ayes and 0 nays.
