

COUNTY COUNCIL
ORDINANCE NO. 98-07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF WARREN COUNTY
ESTABLISHING THE PER DIEM PAYABLE PURSUANT TO THE
COUNTY PRISONER REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, on September 28, 1998, the County Commissioners of Warren County (the "County") adopted Ordinance No. 98-07 (the "Ordinance"), establishing a program of prisoner reimbursement pursuant to IC §§ 35-50-5-4, 36-2-13-15, and 36-2-13-16 (collectively, the Act); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, the County Council of the County (the "Council") wishes to establish the per diem payable by prisoners subject to the Act; and

WHEREAS, on the date hereof the Council has received information that the average daily cost of housing a person in the jail facilities of the County is \$ 30.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF WARREN COUNTY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Based on the information presented to the Council on the date hereof, for purposes of the Act and the Ordinance the per diem cost of housing a prisoner shall be \$ 30.00. The per diem shall be reviewed at least annually but shall remain the same until changed by a future ordinance.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
