Establishment of 911 Emergency Rate

At a regularly scheduled meeting for the purpose of conducting County business, the Warren County Council of Warren County, Indiana, on Monday, February 14, 2005, considered the adoption of an ordinance that would allow the 911 rate, presently \$1.50 per month, to be increased to \$1.67 per month. This should become effective in accordance with Indiana Statute 36-8-16-9 (on the first day of the second month after the month during which the ordinance is adopted).
