

Ordinance 2022-0118 D
AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING REGULATIONS FOR PROPERTY MAINTENANCE IN
WARREN COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Warren County, State of Indiana, (the "Commissioners") previously passed Ordinance No. 2019-0916B relating to property maintenance;

WHEREAS, Warren County enforcement officials have noted that certain time frames for enforcement would be more effective if modified; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners desire to modify Ordinance No. 2019-0916B to shorten the amount of time given to remove junk and abandoned vehicles to better protect the public health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Warren County by reducing the storage of abandoned/junk vehicles within Warren County.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained and Enacted by the Board of Commissioners of Warren County, State of Indiana, that Ordinance No. 2019-0916B is hereby amended as follows:

- 5.7. Abandoned and Junk Vehicles: In cases of actions violating Section 4 of this Ordinance a "Notice of Violation" shall be issued by the authorized enforcement agent requiring the violator to comply with said section within seventy-two (72) hours from the date of delivering the Notice of Violation, or within such extended period as may be determined by the authorized enforcement agent.


All other provisions of Ordinance No. 2019-0916B shall remain in full force and effect.
