

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-0404
REESTABLISHING CUMULATIVE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT FUND
Under Indiana Code 36-9-15.5

BE IT ORDAINED by the Warren County Commissioners of Warren County, Indiana that a need now exists for the reestablishment of a Cumulative Capital Development Fund for the following purposes:


To provide additional revenue for building and infrastructure projects.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Board will adhere to the provisions of Indiana Code 36-9-15.5-6. The proposed fund will not exceed \$0.05 on each \$100 of assessed valuation. Said tax rate will be levied beginning with taxes for 2022 payable 2023.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that proofs of publication of the public hearing held on the 4th day of April, 2022, and a certified copy of this resolution shall be submitted to the Department of Local Government Finance of the State of Indiana as provided by law. This Cumulative Fund is subject to the approval of the Department of Local Government Finance.

Duly adopted by the following vote of the members of said Warren County Commissioners this 4th day of April, 2022.




