

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-0220 A
AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE USE OF FUNDS
FROM THE "FOLLOWELL FUND"

WHEREAS, Lidah Judith Followell created the "Followell Fund" in her Last Will and Testament dated December 4, 1970, for the benefit of the Warren County Home.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Warren County, Indiana receives funds from the "Followell Fund" for the purpose of maintaining the Warren County Home; and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Home has ceased to exist; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners previously designated the funds for the Warren County Health Department as the nearest possible use of such funds in the absence of the Warren County Home; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners believe that the best use of the funds would be to expand the use of the funds to include the use for other health and safety purposes


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Warren County, Indiana that the funds deposited in the "Followell Fund" from the operation of the "Followell Farm" shall be directed to any health and safety purpose in the County, including, but not limited to, the Warren County Health Department, for the safety and welfare of Warren County residents, the closest possible use to the intentions of the Last Will and Testament of Lidah Judith Followell.

So Ordained, this 20th day of February, 2024.




