

**WARREN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MEETING
MONDAY JULY 20, 2026**

The meeting was called to order by Clay Andrews, Commissioner President.

Clay Andrews, Commissioner President lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

1. New Business:

- a. Removing UBO Aug 3rd. John Comer made a motion to approve the amended agenda with a second from Craig Greenwood, all voted in favor. HWC add to the claims.
- b. Craig Greenwood made a motion to approve July 6, 2026 Commissioner Meeting Minutes seconded by John Comer, all voted in favor.
- c. Craig Greenwood made a motion to approve the July 6, 2026 – July 20, 2026 Accounts Payable Claim Dockets with a second from John Comer, all voted in favor.
- d. Craig Greenwood made a motion to approve the July 17, 2026 payroll with a second from John Comer, all voted in favor.
- e. Highway – Herndon stated new dump truck is built, going to upfitter now and should be delivered in approximately 3 months. Peterbilt is requesting payment of truck/bed. Commissioners agreed and approved to pay from permit fund as previously appropriated. Culvert on 1000W is being rebuild so trucks will need to use 900. Rocky Ford has a lot of trees down from bad storm on Saturday. Discussed stone budget exhausted in MVP Restricted, Local Rd & St budget being used. Use restricted MVH for stone will ask for additional appropriation at a later meeting. Damage from storm earlier in the year and FEMA is asking for more information. Stone used to repair road from storm was discussed.
- f. Ordinance Amending Public Access – Andrews and Barce explained adding additional fee per new State Code. John Comer made a motion to approve Ordinance #2026-0720A Amending Procedure for Public Access seconded by Craig Greenwood, all voted in favor.

3. Elected Official/Department Head comments:

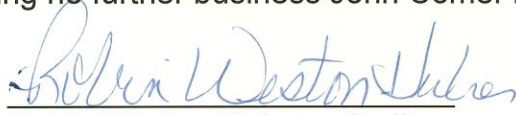
- a. Craig Greenwood, Commissioner – Work on Moores Hill landing slow due to Core of Engineers waiting on to look at. People are using the area.
- b. Clay Andrews, Commissioner – Explained the appraisal of 1000W. Jud Barce explained approval of up to 30 x 775.00, as 9 are 2-3 tracks per person so hoping to pair down to per owner, \$25,000. Discussed putting all expenditures for new dairy under one account code. Reimbursement agreement for future TIF funds was discussed. Clay Andrews made a motion to approve the engagement agreement with Warren Agency appraisal of 1000W for \$23,250 paid from Fund 4918 seconded by John Comer, all voted in favor. John Comer made a motion to create account and additional appropriation of \$23,250 in Fund 4918 seconded by Craig Greenwood, all voted in favor.
- c. Dr. Sharma, Health Officer – State Health Board meeting July 22nd at 7:00 at Ascension Williamsport Hospital. Purdue fellow starting in August and will work for 2 years 3 days a week.
- d. Heather Deno, LEDO Director – Closing out JOINK/READI grant and will request information from Auditor Office. Business study will be finished by end of summer.
- e. Greg Robison, State Line – Introduced new State Line Clerk, Franklin Robison.
- f. Ethan Foxworthy, Council – Stated Budget Meeting will be held July 27th.

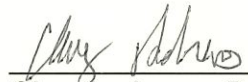

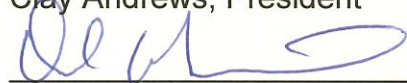

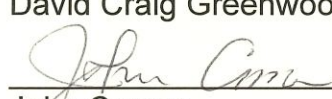
There being no further business John Comer made a motion to adjourn with a second from Craig Greenwood, all voted in favor.
